President Peter O'Toole called the meeting to order at 11:40 and introduced the current board members.

Janet presented the financial report stating that we are financially sound and that the auditors have finished auditing our books and found everything in order.

Peter bid farewell to his presidency and said he appreciated all that he has learned in his time of being MPEA president. MPEA membership recognized Peter and thanked him for his years of service.

Peter explained the voting process for the City, MVNA and Park Board. City has five at-large seats; Park Board and MVNA each have one. There are four officers, President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer for a total of eleven Board seats. Ballots are to be placed in the ballot box by 1 PM. Each candidate running gave a brief introduction of themselves. After introductions were made Peter gave everyone a chance to vote and place their ballots in the ballot box before the meeting continued.

Peter introduced the MPEA negotiation team, Bob Cooper, Michelle Klinga, Mary Meyer, Julie Piwoschuk, Duane Johnson and himself. Bob and Duane updated the membership on contract negotiations. We started out with 32 issues, 18 were MPEA issues and 14 were management issues. We are still negotiating and have a total of 10 issues left. There are two meetings scheduled with management if everything is not concluded by then we will be going to mediation.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:00.
